Revision: An Overview

- I. Get fresh eyes
 - i. Rest
 - ii. Print off or change font/margins (A5 or 6x9" page, 1" margin, indent at .25" or .33")
 - iii. Write a love letter to your manuscript
- II. Make a scene map
 - i. Track relevant details, especially chapter, scene, scene job, and notes
 - ii. List scenes on sticky note on chapter; fill out spreadsheet, along with notes for revision
- III. Revise each chapter for big picture and line edit details
